Meeting Locations and Schedule

Our regular meetings are normally held either at a downtown Los Angeles location or on the West Side.

Our schedule generally is as follows:

- 4:55 p.m. Professional Development Session (1 CPE)
- 5:45 p.m. Networking Reception
- 6:45 p.m. Dinner Program (1 CPE)

In order to take full advantage of all that FEI has to offer, members must join both FEI and our local chapter. Although membership dues are separate, only one membership application is needed.

Eligibility

CFOs or Audit Committee members of publicly traded companies automatically qualify. In all other cases, applicants must be employed by a company that meets one of the following criteria and hold the position of CFO, Treasurer, Controller or similar title.

- \$2M net worth
- \$5M capital (combined net worth and long-term debt)
- \$10M or more in annual revenues
- \$8M in operating expenses
- Financial institutions - \$200M total assets
- Government corporations/authorities - \$40M total assets

If you are currently in transition and, when employed would have qualified for membership, you may still qualify to join, at a reduced rate. Please refer to the requirements for the in-transition category on our website.
